

## More responsibilities with less pay.



**Private sector direct support professionals (DSPs) enable people with disabilities to live, work, and participate in their communities in contrast to public sector DSPs who work in state institutions. Even with added responsibility for community inclusion, private sector DSPs are paid an average of \$6,645 less than their public sector peers.**
